Jeans are welcome at the funeral in tribute to Sharon's limitations she overcame.

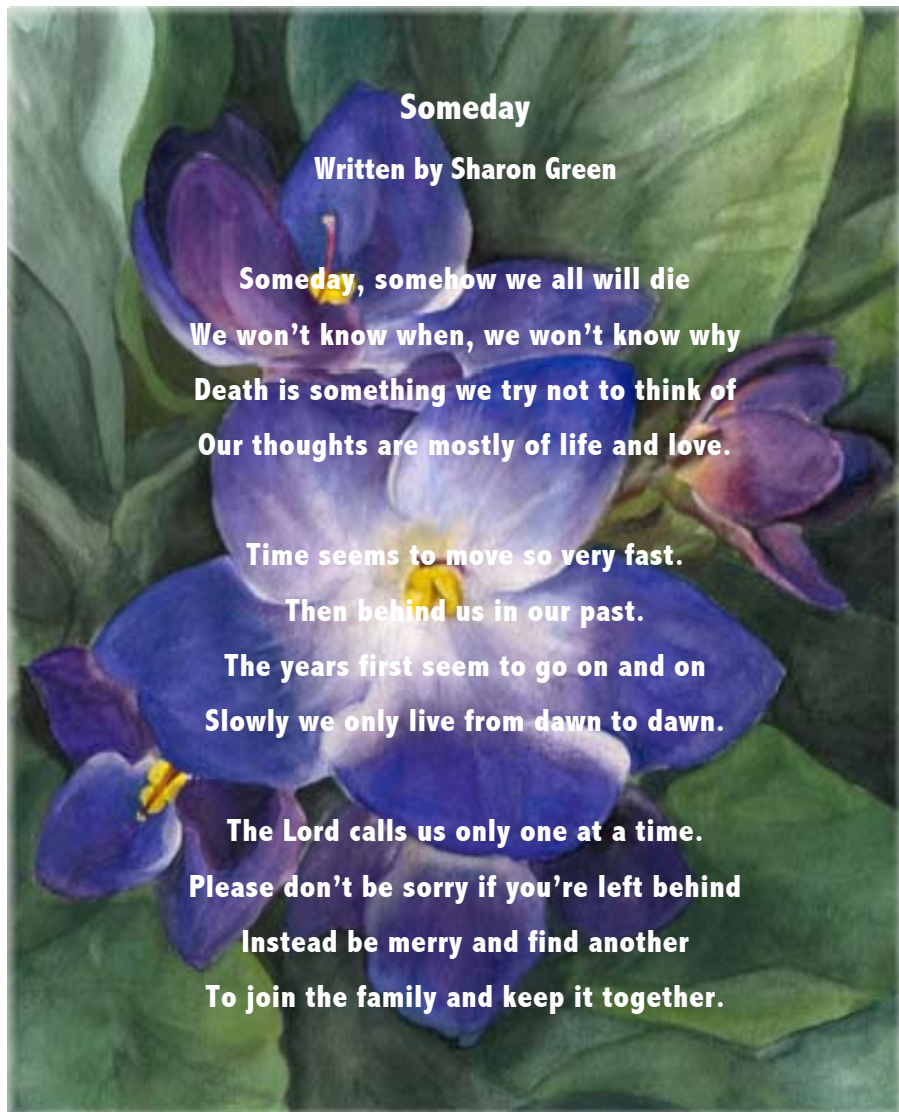
