Scott was a long-time member of the Riverside Evangelical Free Church in Linn Grove. He also spent most of his life working as a carpenter.

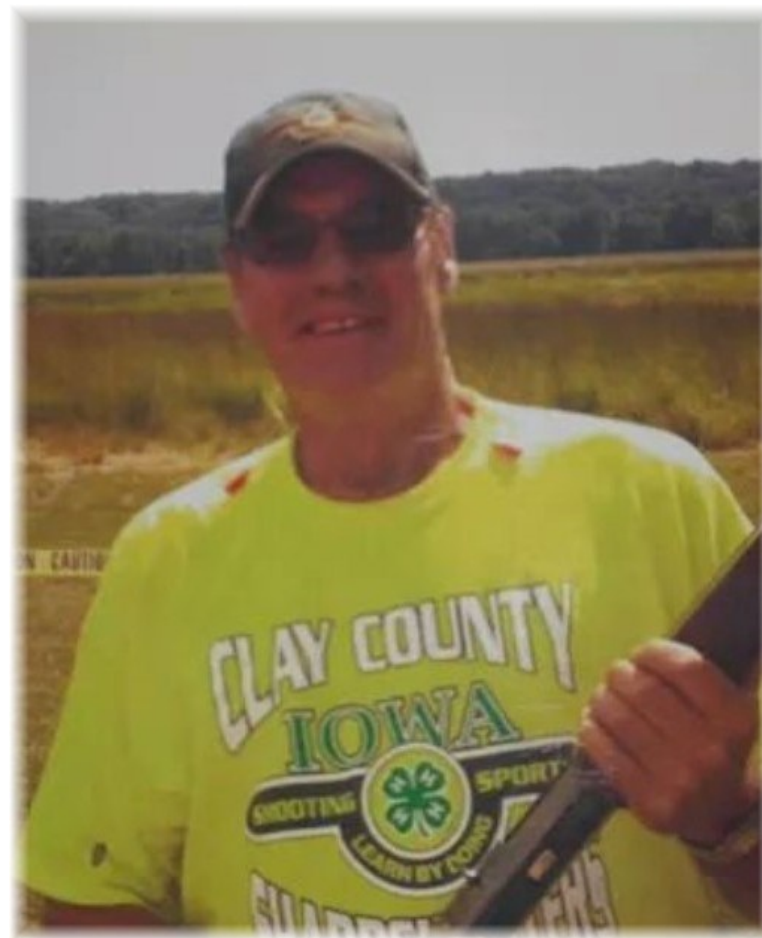

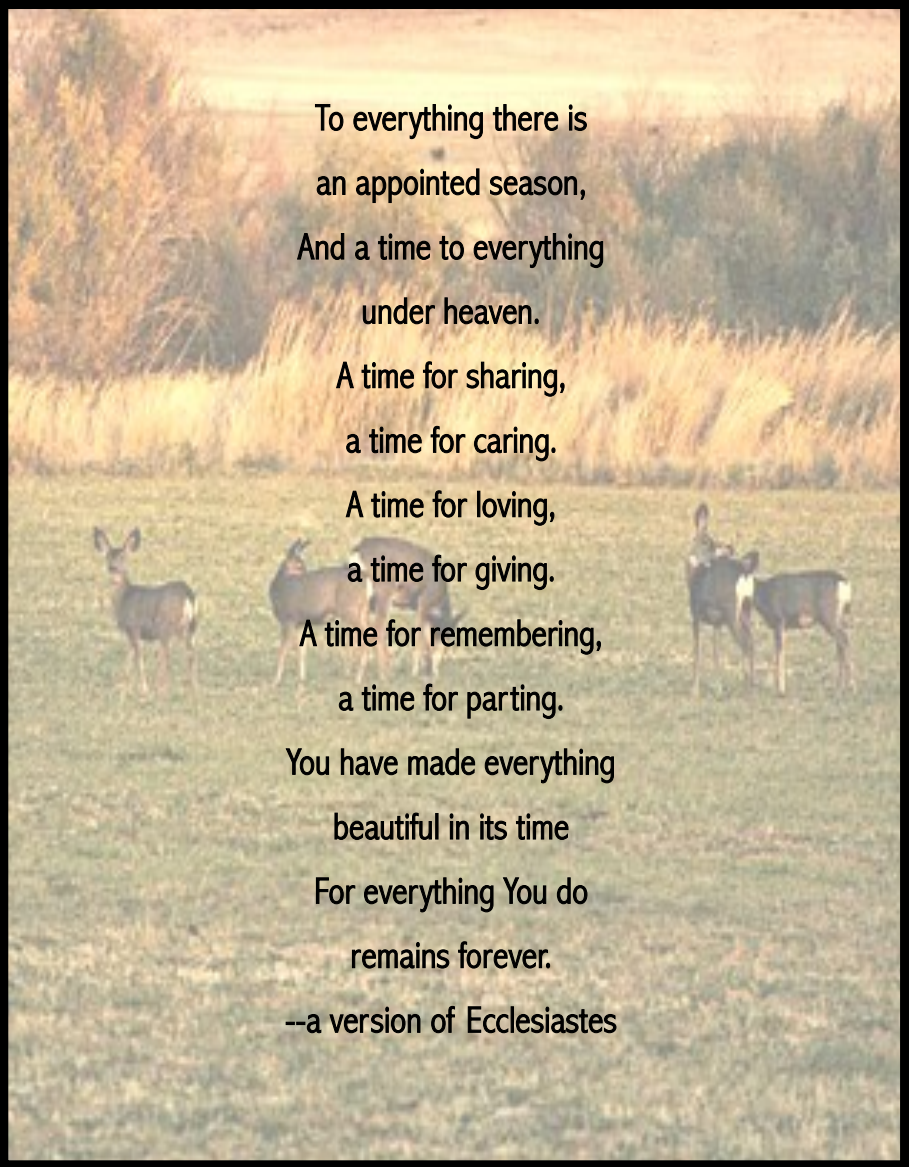
