He was preceded in death by his parents and three brothers: Paul, August, and Ray.

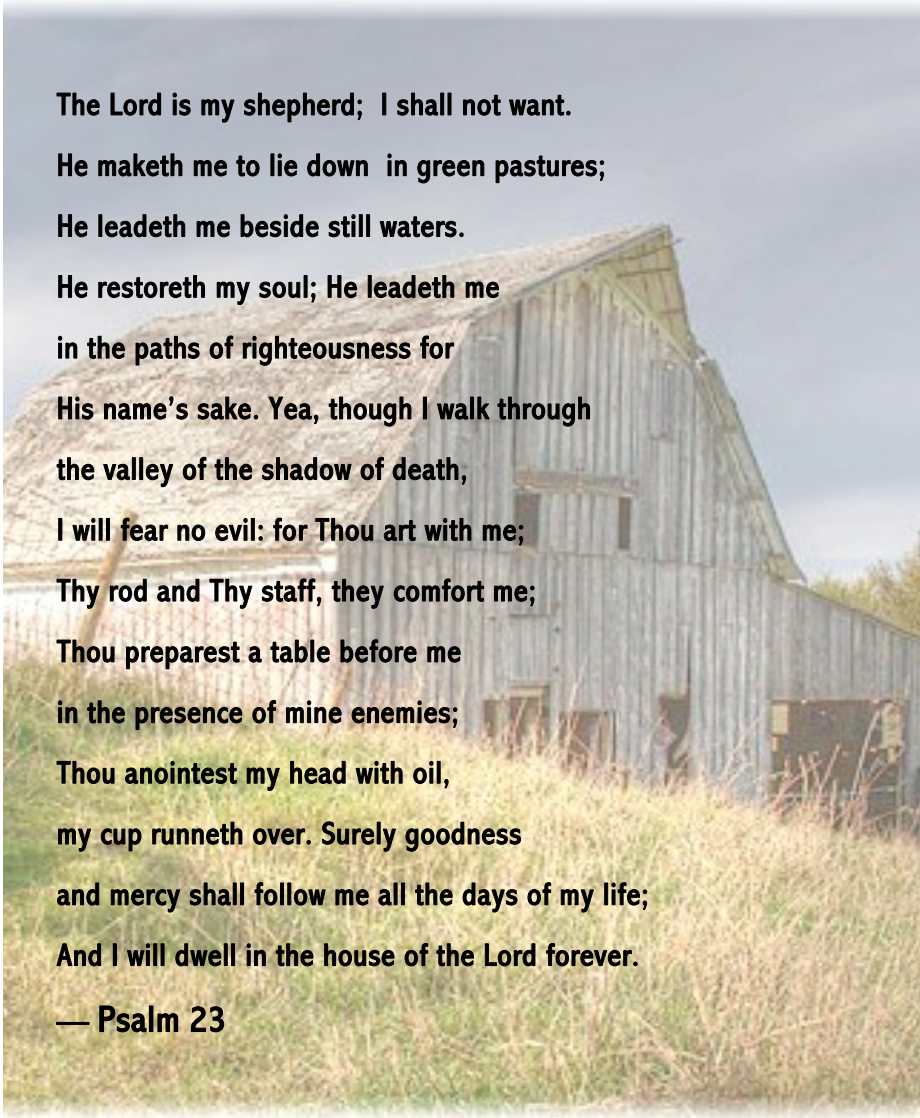
