Mariah was so very young, so there are many loved ones that we are unable to mention, but we want you all to know we have thought of you and love you all.

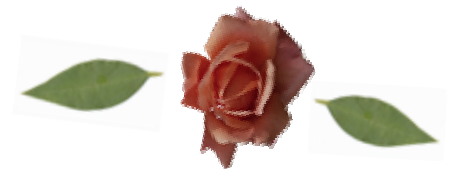
