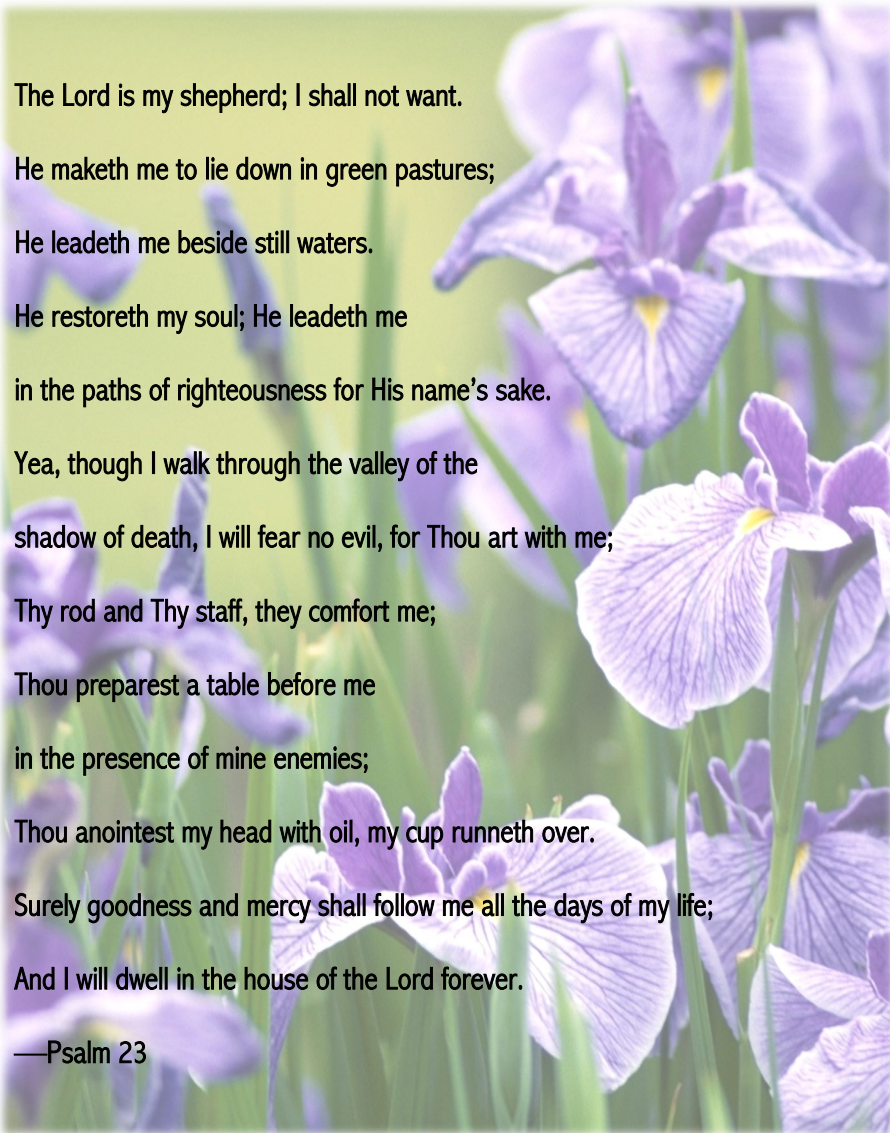
She was preceded in death by her parents; her son-in-law, Robert Evans; one brother and one sister.
