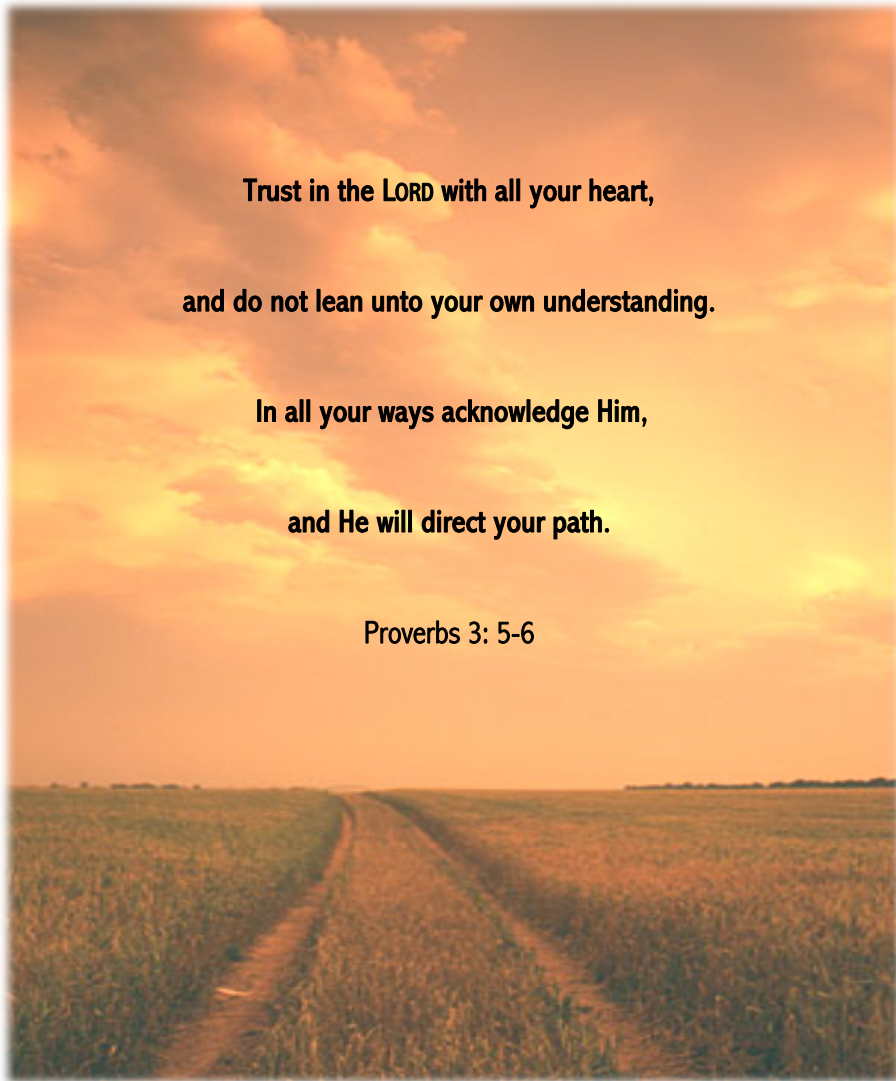
She was preceded in death by her parents; her son-in-law, Paul Paulsen; and her sister, Charlotte Fredrickson.
